

What is His Name?

There are 22 letters in the Hebrew alef-bet. By putting each letter of Proverbs 30.4-6 into a 22-letter grid (ELS/equidistant letter spacing), we can find the Name of His Son:

DW7 intersects with YNW in the form of a cross—the Name is Yeshua!
